Criteria for Student Selection

To qualify for the Ohtaki exchange program students must:

- Be 12 to 18 years at the time of travel.
- Be a resident of the Cowichan Valley.
- Have strong interpersonal skills and a good behaviour record.
- Have parental/guardian consent.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member (e.g. a teacher, principal, minister, youth group leader etc.)
- Be willing to participate in all activities.
- Must cover all costs of the trip and meet the deadlines for payment. (Costs will be reduced by the amount of fund-raising, if any, for those that participate)
- The family must be willing to go through a Criminal Record Check.

In order for a student to qualify for the Ohtaki exchange one parent must be an active Committee member until both exchanges have occurred. The parent must regularly attend the monthly Ohtaki Twinning Committee meetings, and the parent must assist with the work of the Committee. Monthly parent fund-raising meetings will be held at the discretion of the Fundraising Committee. Fundraising efforts are the responsibility of the student and parents.

Please note: preference will be given to students who are also willing to host a guest from Ohtaki.

By signing the form, parents and students agree to all the criteria listed above. Failure to meet the criteria could make a student ineligible right up to departure time.
