**A BYLAW TO AMEND TICKET INFORMATION BYLAW 728-2001**

---

**WHEREAS** Section 264 of the *Community Charter* authorizes Council to, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which the municipal ticket may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;

**AND WHEREAS** Council is authorized to designate the use of any word or expression issued by a bylaw enforcement officer to designate an offence against a bylaw;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Community Charter* authorizes Council by law to set the amount of fines prescribed by regulation;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Lake Cowichan deems it expedient to amend Bylaw No. 728-2001 to allow for revisions to with respect to the municipal ticket information system;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Lake Cowichan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

**1. TITLE**

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Town of Lake Cowichan Ticket Information Amendment Bylaw No. 1086-2022".

**2. AMENDMENT**

Schedule K of Bylaw No. 728-2001 is amended by deleting it in its entirety and substituting it with "Schedule A" attached to this Bylaw.

**3. FORCE AND EFFECT**

That upon adoption of this bylaw, Bylaw No. 1086-2022, the Town of Lake Cowichan Ticket Information Bylaw No. 728-2001 shall hereby be amended and take effect.

READ A FIRST TIME on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022.

READ A SECOND TIME on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022.

READ A THIRD TIME on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022.

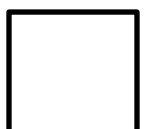
