40th ANNUAL Panago Grande Parade Guidelines and Safety Rules

- ❖ No items may be thrown from any parade entry for safety reasons. Entrants are allowed to provide walkers alongside the entry to hand out candy, coupons or flyers. Violation of this policy will prohibit participation in future parades.
- ❖ Parade officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that is in violation of these rules.
- ❖ Once your entry has started along the parade route, no additional persons may board your float
- ❖ Your entry may not exit the parade route prior to the end of the parade (exception given to emergency vehicles)
- ❖ No alcohol is allowed
- ❖ No political or advocacy propaganda is allowed. Violation of this policy will prohibit participation in future parades.
- ❖ All wheels must be free from obstruction
- ❖ It is recommended that a fire extinguisher be on board of all floats
- ❖ All entries must have clear signage
- ❖ All motorized vehicles must have valid insurance papers on hand during the parade. All parade drivers must have a valid driver's license.
- ❖ Seatbelts must be worn by persons seated or standing in units
- ❖ **NO STOPPING FOR DEMO'S OR PERFORMANCES. NO GAPS PLEASE!!**
- ❖ Changes in parade line up the day of the parade will be at the sole discretion of the parade organizer.
