- The Commission expressed support for promoting existing rebates to ensure the use of efficient heating systems that are less polluting.

Councillor Austin offered to provide information she gathered from Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI) during Mayor Rod's tenure on a study that was conducted for a bypass.
