## **BACKGROUND**

The Town of Lake Cowichan submitted a grant application under the Community Resiliency Investment Program for a Community Resiliency project in 2021. The application was submitted before October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 without a council resolution.

The project is intended to engage all of the members of the community to better prepare them to deal with the impact and threat of a wildfire event. Additionally, the program should provide the Town with tools to be effective in creating a fire smart and resilient community.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

A council resolution as recommended by UBCM should read as follows:

that Council approve the making of a grant application under the 2021 Community Resiliency Investment (CRI) program through UBCM for an amount up to \$130,160;

and that it further provides assurance that it would support all the proposed activities under the plan and would undertake the overall proper fiscal management of the grant.
