**NOTES:**

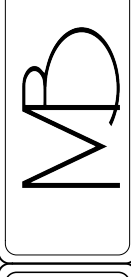
- Recommend complete removal of invasive plants such as English Ivy & Himalayan Blackberry prior to retaining wall construction to minimize re-emergence.
- Recommend stockpiling and using native streamside soil for re-soiling below new retaining wall.
- Soil on top side of wall to be imported weed-free high quality garden soil including minimum 30% well aged compost to approx 1' (30cm) depth.
- Growing media shall be substantially free of plants or their roots, building materials, invasive or noxious plants and their reproductive parts, non composted wood, wood waste, insect pests, plant pathogenic organisms, ice, chemical pollutants or substances at levels toxic to plants, and other extraneous materials that detract from the desirable physical and chemical properties required for landscaping purposes.
- Upper planting bed (above wall) to be mulched with 3" (8cm) organic, well decomposed mulch such as fish compost. A small amount of bonemeal may be added to planting holes.
- Plant substitutions may be required due to availability. Consult the landscape designer for acceptable substitutions.
