SUBJECT: Update on CLEC and Lakeview Campsite

With the 2021 budget getting closer to approval, we are looking forward to getting started with some of the capital projects that are necessary for the maintenance of the Centre and the park to acceptable standards for our guests.

Covid continues to provide challenging times for all venues that rely on bookings and events for economic stability. However, the Centre has indeed been fortunate to have partnered with the School District 79 international programme for a limited number of bookings for 2021.

In April we will have 17 full days of work for our staff as we provide a quarantine setting for approximately 30 international students and School District staff.

The SD 79 hopes to book additional time for this year.

We continue to have strong interest in using the centre for groups and organizations hoping for 2021. Realistically we anticipate and hope that 2022 will be the recovery year .

Also noteworthy is a new look for our website that will be on line within the next month as it is being updated.

Lakeview park campground will be open for the May long weekend and the hiring of summer staff will take place prior to the opening.

The floating board walk needs some repairs, and we will also be attending to the repair and maintenance of the boardwalk to ensure that conditions are safe.

We will also be adding more picnic tables to the beach and adding sand in the appropriate areas for the enjoyment and safety of our guests.

We anticipate that we will have a very busy season as all indications are that campers can hardly wait to enjoy the outdoors.
