Park Closure Bylaw 980-2016

The Town of Lake Cowichan is proposing to close a portion of parkland to facilitate the registration of Rights of Way in favour of BC Hydro to accommodate BC Hydro's need to operate and maintain distribution and transmission lines within that statutory right of way. The Town does not intend to dispose of the closed portion of the park.

If you are opposed to the Town adopting the required "Town of Lake Cowichan Park Closure Bylaw No. 980-2016", you may indicate your opposition by signing and returning this *Elector Response Form* to the Town office **no later** than 4:00 pm on Monday, September 19th, 2016. Only those persons who live or own property within the Town of Lake Cowichan and who meet the following qualifications are eligible to submit an *Elector Response Form*.

I hereby certify that:

- I am a Canadian citizen;
- I am an individual who is age 18 or older;
- I have been a resident of British Columbia for at least the past six months;
- I have been a resident of the Town of Lake Cowichan for the past 30 days **or** I am entitled to register as a non-resident property elector;
- I am not disqualified by the *Local Government Act*, or any other enactment, from voting in an election or am not otherwise disqualified by law.

I understand and acknowledge that I may not sign an *Elector Response Form* more than once in relation to this alternative approval process.
