



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Burning Regulation

Residents should be aware that on August 26, 2008 the Town of Lake Cowichan passed the *Outdoor Burning Regulation Bylaw No. 851*. The bylaw prohibits ALL OUTDOOR burning except for:

- Cooking fires with a base 4 square feet or smaller; and
- Ceremonial/special event fires under Permit issued by the Fire Chief.

Outdoor burning to dispose of ANY AND ALL waste material is prohibited and violations may result in a fine of \$100.00 per incident.

Your efforts to dispose of waste without burning are appreciated and will help improve air quality benefiting yourself, your neighbours, and your community.

Thank you again for your cooperation.

Witnesses: please record the date, time and location of prohibited fires. Report the incident to Bylaw Enforcement during regular business by calling 250-749-6681.
