Work in Progress:

The following work has been completed or is in progress:

- As winter is here a reminder to all residents that it is your responsibility to keep sidewalks adjacent to your property clear of snow. This is much appreciated as the Town works crew can not get to all the sidewalks in Town and clear snow.
- The public works crew continues to do regular maintenance around Town.
- The new bus pullover on Cowichan Lake Road is now 85% complete. The curb, sidewalk and paving portion have been completed. We are currently waiting on BC Hydro to do a pole relocate, and we will be installing a bench and shelter for the bus users.
- We have completed a new water main and services on Nitinat Ave.
- We have completed some paving on Neva Road.
- Greendale Road sanitary main upgrades are in the design phase and we're hoping to have this out for tender early 2023.
- Public works is planning capital projects for 2023.

We are currently looking at the following projects for 2023:

- Sanitary wastewater lagoon upgrades to meet Ministry regulations. We have made a grant application and are waiting to hear if the Town is successful in receiving the grant.
- Some water main upgrades around Town have been identified. We will be doing some engineering design work to have these projects shovel ready for when funding is available.
- Sanitary main upgrades where inflow and infiltration has been identified is being reviewed.
- Road paving and sidewalks projects are being reviewed.
