The Lake Cowichan Fire Department with help from donations from the community has completed the building of a permanent display for the original #1 Engine. This building is located at the current Fire Hall location on North Shore Rd adjacent to the bus stop in the south corner of the east parking lot.

The project turned out very well and enables views of the Engine #1 as well as articles of firefighting history in the Lake Cowichan Area. It is able to be viewed year round, 24 hours a day as it is a separate building from the Fire Hall.

We are currently raising funds for the restoration of Engine #1. It needs body work , engine as well as exhaust work. We currently have a restoration budget of \$35,000 and have raised \$25,000 so far. My contact information is above if you have any questions or wish to make a donation.
