SUBJECT: Generator Installation at Municipal Hall

BACKGROUND

In March 2020 an application was made for funding under the Community Emergency Preparedness Fund for the maximum grant of \$25,000 to partially finance an emergency generator for the Municipal Hall. The funding was approved on May 28th, 2020, and we were given a deadline date of May 31st, 2021, to complete the purchases. I have been able to get extensions on it until this month, but our luck has run out as no more extensions are forthcoming.

We have received three quotes on the supply and installation of the generator that do not include GST from:

Frontier power products	\$ 93,901.65
Cummins Power	\$102,963.60
Simson Maxwell	\$153,119.38

Our electrical consultant RB Engineering views all proponents as reputable generator suppliers and in-line with its engineering's expectations.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

that the Committee recommend approval for the supply and installation of an automatic generator at the Municipal Hall from Frontier Power Products in the amount of \$93,901.65 Plus GST.
