Parking Lot Issues around Town

I have spoken with several people around Town, regarding the summer time parking issues in town specially around the Saywell Park area .

Also with the help of Katherine Worsley from the chamber of commerce I also receive a number of comment from local businesses and residents.

I have been in touch with Robbins Parking and they have provided some options the Town can consider.

It is recommended that the Saywell and Pharmacy parking lots are to be one or two hour only parking only.

Street parking in these areas to be the same depending on the area

This will allow locals and visitors to visit the down town areas to enjoy the parks and businesses .

Robbins can provide the following services .

1. They can provide Metered parking .
2. They can provide and install signage that Robbins is Patrolling the parking lots ,with the rules ,regulation and fines.

3. They can provide patrol personal, fine or towing vehicles that are over parked .
4. They can provide the Town staff with Equipment and training to patrol the parking lots., and fine or tow vehicles.

This is some information to review and discussion ,and we can come up with a plan that works .
