Work in Progress

The following is the work that has been completed or is in progress:

- The catch basin and culvert inlet and outlet cleaning maintenance is continuing as time permits.
- We are currently working on some road and sidewalk repairs.
- Sanitary pump station maintenances and upgrade are ongoing.
- The Arbutus Ave. sanitary contract was scheduled to start August 17, 2021. The contractor, however, could not fulfill his commitment and backed out of the job. It is being re tendered.
- We have again begun cleaning culvert inlets and outlets as the rain season is coming.
- Street sweeping is on going around Town as time allows.
- The new bus shelter has been installed near the Fields Store. The old shelter is scheduled to be removed this winter.
- Works crew still cleaning up on the paving projects. There is still some work to completed at King Goerge crossing.
- We have replaced a section of sidewalk from Poplar going back towards the roundabout. It now requires patch paving.
- We have encountered a number of watermain breaks again.

- A reminder to all residents, it is your responsibility to keep sidewalks and boulevards adjacent to their property clear of brush, weeds, tree limbs, leaves, refuse, etc. Hedges must be kept trimmed to the back of the sidewalks. We appreciate those that are cooperating and maintaining the area adjacent to their property. To others that are not, this is becoming a safety issue, please make an effort to clean up your boulevard ,and prevent any accidents or injuries.
- Planning for other project for this year continue.
