Work in Progress

The following is the work that has been completed or is in progress:

- Public works has completed some more danger tree removal at Pine street, and King George roundabout.
- We encountered a sanitary line blockage due to tree roots penetrating into the pipe at the joints. This tree will need to be removed and some pipe repairs are required.
- The catch basin and culvert inlet and outlet cleaning maintenance is continuing.
- There are some more new potholes around town which will require repairs.
- Sanitary pump station – maintenance and upgrade are ongoing.
- Arbutus Ave. Sanitary I & I Engineering work has been completed, approved by Public works Superintendent. We would like to send this out for quotes next week.
- The oil spill cleanup on Park Road has been over seen by Stantec Engineering and has been on going well. All costs are to be covered by the property owners insurance company.
- Contract to repair boom sticks around the town raw water intake has been awarded and the Town is waiting on the contractor to provide a start date to complete this work. I have asked for an update on the schedule .

- We encounter a few snow events, over all our snow clearing went well other than a few delays due to manpower.
 - The Town crew has been out doing some street sweeping , They will be out again after the winter events to clean up any sand etc. on the streets.
 - Planning for Spring and Summer 2021 projects is underway.

- A reminder to all residents that it is their responsibility to keep sidewalks and boulevards adjacent to their property clear of brush, weeds, tree limbs, leaves, refuse, etc. Hedges must be kept trimmed to the back of the side walks.
 - Just a reminder, after reviewing our curb side organics and refuse collection ,for the months of November, 2021 thru January, 2022 ,that the organic will get collected every second week as the refuse does.

3. South Shore Road from Stone Ave. to Sall Road.
4. Cowichan Ave. from King George round about to Pine St.
5. Stone Ave. from South Shore to Hemlock.
6. North Shore Road - Tim Hortons to Fire Hall
7. North Shore Road from LCFN to River Road and Park
8. Complete sidewalk entrance of Town at Lake Cowichan Lodge. On list for 2021
9. South shore road. from # 154 to # 162 and around the corner on Cowichan. (on list for 2021)
10. Cowichan Lake road From # 82 to 92 (Stanley Road)
