Work in Progress

The following is the work that has been completed or is in progress:

- The catch basin and culvert inlet and outlet cleaning maintenance is continuing as we can make time.
- We are currently working on some road and sidewalk repairs.
- Sanitary pump station maintenances and upgrade are ongoing.
- Arbutus Ave. Sanitary up grades. We received additional quotes and now have awarded the job. Scheduled to start August 17, 2021
- The oil spill cleanup on Park Road is completed ,there are some side walk repairs to do done by the contractor.
- Street sweeping is on going around Town as time allows.
- The New bus shelter has been installed near the Fields store .
- Works crew still cleaning up on the paving projects as we have time. There is still some work to completed at King Goerge crossing.
- The new overflow parking lot off Point Ideal Road seems to be successful, it is well used. We are still facing a few challenges with people over parking in some areas.
- A part of River road Hill has been repaved , this was a requirement for the new subdivision and at the cost of the Developer.

- To all residents, it is your responsibility to keep sidewalks and boulevards adjacent to their property clear of brush, weeds, tree limbs, leaves, refuse, etc. Hedges must be kept trimmed to the back of the sidewalks. We appreciate those that are cooperating and maintaining the area adjacent to their property.
