Work in Progress

The following is the work that has been completed or is in progress:

- We have been working on some up grades on the sanitary out fall line SRW, so works crew can drive down to the river for regular maintenance and inspections.
- Sanitary out fall annual inspection and report has been completed and sent to the appropriate ministry.
- The catch basin and culvert inlet and outlet cleaning maintenance is on-going.
- We are currently working on some road and sidewalk repairs.
- Sanitary pump station maintenances and upgrade are ongoing.
- Arbutus Ave. sanitary up grades - We have requested additional quotes and they look promising.
- The oil spill cleanup on Park Road is getting close to completion.
- Street sweeping is on-going around Town as time allows.
- Works crews are finishing up the clean up on the paving projects as we have time. Some work needs to be completed at the King Goerge crossing.
- The new overflow parking lot off Point Ideal Road is working out well and it is well used.
- The two-hour parking appears to be working in places. Most people observe and abide by the two parking limits and several tickets have been issued.

- To all residents, it is your responsibility to keep sidewalks and boulevards adjacent to their property clear of brush, weeds, tree limbs, leaves, refuse, etc. Hedges must be kept trimmed to the back of the sidewalks. We appreciate those that are cooperating and maintaining the areas adjacent to their property. To others that are not, this is becoming a safety issue, please try to clean up your boulevard to prevent any accidents or injuries.
