Work in Progress

The following is the work that has been completed or is in progress:

- Water main flushing is completed for this year.
- Sanitary line flushing is completed for this year unless something new comes up.
- The catch basin and culvert inlet and outlet cleaning maintenance is continuing as we can make time.
- We hope to get some road and sidewalk repairs done this Month.
- Sanitary pump station maintenances and upgrade are ongoing.
- Arbutus Ave. Sanitary up grades. We have received the quotes and they are all over budget. Unfortunately we have had to cancel the project for now.
- The oil spill cleanup on Park Road is still on going.
- Street sweeping is on going around Town.
- Towns paving sidewalk projects for this year Johel road and King George Ave. have been paved, there is still some small item to finish up the projects.
- The new overflow parking lot off Point Ideal Road has been completed.
- As of June 11, we have begun installing 2 hour parking signs around Town.
- Robbins Parking has been up and delivered signs for the Town crew to install. Monitoring and ticketing equipment has been delivered and training has provided.

- A reminder to all residents that it is their responsibility to keep sidewalks and boulevards adjacent to their property clear of brush, weeds, tree limbs, leaves, refuse, etc. Hedges must be kept trimmed to the back of the side walks.
- Planning for other project for this year continue.
