Work in Progress

The following is the work that has been completed or is in progress:

- Sanitary pump station maintenances and upgrade are ongoing. Pine Street Pump Station we have installed two new isolation valves on the exterior of the building.
- Arbutus Ave. Sanitary upgrades. We had three contractors look at the project and two submitted quotes. It was recommended by the engineer to award it to the lowest tendered price.
- We are again cleaning culvert inlets and outlets as the rain season is here and we need to ensure water is flowing without obstructions.
- Street sweeping is on going around Town as time allows.
- The Town will be re roofing the Visitor center and the covered area at Saywell Park. A contract has been awarded.
- Works crew are still cleaning up on the paving projects as we have time. There is still some work to completed at King George crossing.
- We have had a number of water line breaks again this past month.
- The Catch Basin cleaning and Maintenance is continuing as the wet weather is here and we to ensure water is flowing with out obstructions.

- To all residents, it is your responsibility to keep sidewalks and boulevards adjacent to their property clear of brush, weeds, tree limbs, leaves, refuse, etc. Hedges must be kept trimmed to the back of the sidewalks. We appreciate those that are cooperating and maintaining the area adjacent to their property. To others that are not, this is becoming a safety issue, please make an effort to clean up your boulevard, and prevent any accidents or injuries.
- There is a bear problem around town. A reminder to all resident and businesses to please keep your garbage container secured, inside or in a compound where the bears or other animals can't get at them.
- Reminder to all, the town only picks up garbage contains that have the lid closed. Extra garbage that is piled on top of the can beside the can or piled in the can with the lid open will not be picked up.

- Planning for other projects for this year and next year continues.
